BEYOND THE CLASSROOM

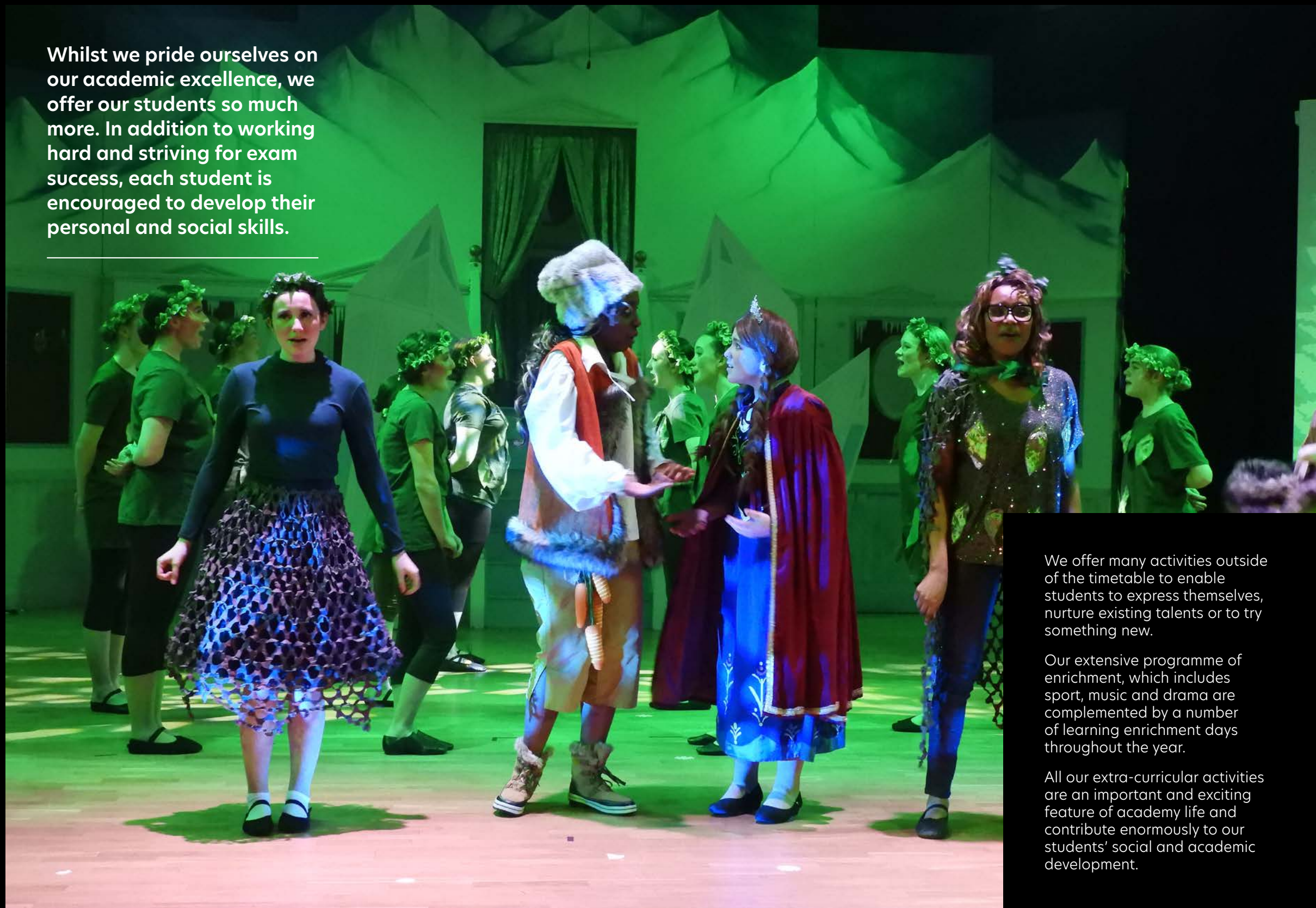
